1. Credit Accumulation and Transfer

- Mapping your ABC account ensures that your earned credits are securely recorded and can be transferred if you switch institutions or pursue a different course.

2. Unified Academic Record

- By linking your ABC account with the Samarth Student Portal, you maintain a consolidated academic record accessible anytime. This ensures your academic achievements are recognized across various platforms and institutions.

The following are steps to Link your ABC Account in Samarth Student Portal:

3. Click on ABC Account
4. Click on Link / Create ABC Account
5. Enter details on Digi locker website
6. Click on Allow to fetch ABC Id
