REPORT ON FIVE-DAY WORKSHOP ON E-TYPING SKILLS IN DEVANAGARI SCRIPT Organized by Dept. of Sanskrit, Cachar College (03-04-2023 to 07-04-2023)

An innovative workshop on E-typing skills in Devanägari script was held from 03-04-2023 to 07-04-2023 at Cachar College, Silchar. Due to public holidays on 4th, 7th and 9th April 2023, the workshop was automatically extended till 10th April 2023. As many Indian languages such as Sanskrit, Hindi, Bodo, Marathi, Nepali use this Devanågarī script, the ability to type electronically in it will undoubtedly prepare the future graduates profitably for the job market. Fields where they can be easily be recruited are Publishing, Printing, Manuscript research, Creative writing, Museology, Journalism and Translation departments.

Former Head, Dept. of Sanskrit, Dr. Shamita Nag Dhar (Retd.) was the Chief Guest. Other guests were the Head of Dept. of History Muhammad Shamsuddin, Head of Dept. of Hindi Dr. Shankar Sharma and IQAC Coordinator, Dr. Nitu Debnath. The meeting was presided over by the Head of Dept. of Bengali, Dr. Sudip Das. The program started with lighting of lamps by the guests accompanied by chanting of Hymns by Cocoordinator Ms. Nayana Goswami and students of Dept. of Sanskrit.

Explaining the purpose of the workshop, the Coordinator, Dr. Shilpi Dutta Majumder, HOD, Dept of Sanskrit informed that the need of students skilled in typing in Devanägari was felt during departmental work like journal-editing, digital seminars, online examinations etc. Also this skill helps in personal writings, research papers, question papers, banners, power-point presentations, smart-classroom teaching etc without depending on outsourced typists. It saves time, effort, money, paper, storage etc. Especially with the help of the Internet, auto-correct spelling and grammar-friendly features can be used, preventing plagiarism, maintaining confidentiality and avoiding the pitfalls of illegible handwriting.

The guests praised such an important workshop. Muhammad Shamsuddin said that the role of Devanågari in deciphering copperplates, inscriptions and manuscripts written during the patronage of ancient India's monarchies and republics is immense. Dr. Shankar Sharma said that it is impossible to establish oneself at the all-India level without knowing the Devanägari script. Such workshops will also help graduates to write better spelling. Dr. Shamita Nagdhar said that as Sanskrit is a very successful language in computer programming, such workshops will provide a beautiful bridge between Sanskrit and other languages. Dr. Sudip Das appreciated such workshops and encouraged the students to master this skill. He wished the participants an enjoyable and enriching workshop and a bright career.

A power-point presentation on the utility of E-typing skills delivered by the Coordinator in the inaugural session was the highlight of the program. Written study material was handed out to participants and technical sessions were carried out in allotted time slots in the E-library of the College where practical hands-on training was imparted. Thirty two students had applied for the workshop. Due to inclement weather, twenty six students could register in the inaugural session and twenty five received certificates after a test conducted in the closing session. The Feedback given by participants was appreciated and students were encouraged to practise in the E-library even in future. A participant also made an edited videography of the workshop. The prominent speakers on the closing day were Dr. Ratan Das, HOD, Dept. of Commerce, Dr. Shankar Sharma, HOD, Hindi and Librarian, Dr. Deepshikha Sen. They reiterated that knowledge of a subject and its related skills are equally important. The speakers therefore appreciated this effort and wished the participants success in their future assignments.

The Programme was Chaired by Sri Kiriti Bhusan Dey, Principal in Charge of the College. Dr. Joydeep Biswas, Associate Professor, Department of Economics and Member of NEP 2020 Implementation Committee, Assam University Silchar addressed the gathering regarding NEP 2020 implementation strategies and guidelines adopted by the Affiliating University.

Report of the

RUSA 2.0 sponsored Training Programme on NAAC Preparedness & NEP 2020 Implementation in colleges of Assam (Barak Valley Zone) organised by Cachar College, Silchar in collaboration with UGC-HRDC, Gauhati University, Guwahati on 17 March, 2023.

The Inaugural session of the day long Training Programme on NAAC Preparedness & NEP 2020 Implementation started with felicitation of the Dignitaries on the dais by the Teachers of Cachar College followed by chanting of Saraswati Vandana by Smt. Nayana Goswami, Assistant Professor, Department of Sanskrit, Cachar College, Silchar. Welcome address was delivered by the Hon'ble Principal-in-charge of Cachar College, Sri Kiriti Bhusan Dey. The Programme Coordinator from UGC-HRDC, Gauhati University, Prof. Parag Phukan delivered his speech on the purpose of the Programme and lucidly elaborated many facets & necessities of NAAC Assessment and NEP 2020 Implementation in the current context.

The Programme was attended by 26 participants, comprising 08 participants from Govt. Model College, Borkhola, 09 from Nehru College, Pailapool and 09 participants from Host College. There was no participant from Janata College, Kabuganj in the Training Programme, which was one of the participating Colleges as per Programme schedule prepared by UGC-HRDC, GU.

In the first Technical session Resource person, Dr. Apratim Nag, Associate Professor, Department of Physics & IQAC Coordinator, Gurucharan College, Silchar initiated deliberation on importance, various constraints and the clue to overcome them regarding NAAC Assessment. He also beautifully narrated the entire process of NAAC Assessment in step by step manner.

In the 2nd Technical Session the other Resource Person, Dr. Nitu Debnath, Assistant Professor, Department of Zoology & Coordinator, IQAC, Cachar College, Silchar highlighted the origin, need and core values of periodic NAAC Assessment and its benefits to HEIs as prescribed in the NAAC Guideline. He also elaborated the distribution of weightages across various Key Indicators under all the 7 criteria for assessment, the various qualitative & quantitative matrices and provided necessary suggestions how a particular HEI can score better in certain criteria based on revised Assessment criteria, latest SOP and Benchmarks set for the purpose.

The 3rd Technical session on NEP 2020 Implementation was started with the deliberation from Dr. Apratim Nag, who lucidly elaborated the principles of NEP 2020 and also informed the trainee about the updated status of NEP Curriculum Framework designed by Assam University, Silchar based on UGC Curriculum Framework & OM notified by Govt. of Assam dated 27 January, 2023.

In the 4th Technical session, Dr. Nitu Debnath discussed many salient features of the NEP 2020 and how implementation of the Policy by Assam University, Silchar is going to impact the higher education scenario in the colleges under Barak Valley Zone in particular. Dr. Debnath also highlighted the importance of NEP 2020 guideline from affiliating University regarding curriculum design & development by respective BUGS and in solving many issues relating to appropriate implementation of the National Education Policy without compromising the benefits a learner in higher education can derive from the emerging system of education. Deliberations in all the four sessions of the Training Programme attracted multiple vital queries from the participants on NAAC preparedness & NEP Implementation, which were addressed by the resource persons based on the training received at UGC-HRDC, GU and their own previous experiences. The entire process of Q & A or interaction was catalysed by Prof. Parag Phukan, who played significant role to make the Training sessions vibrant by lucidly explaining the methods, pros and cons of various issues, challenges and their possible solutions to successfully complete the A & A by NAAC. Prof. Phukan expressed serious concern on the deviations in the draft NEP curriculum framework of Assam University from the UGC Model Guideline and OM served by Govt. of Assam and their possible consequences on the learners in terms of mobility and flexibility. He requested the participants and Resource Persons to take up these issues in the upcoming meetings of the NEP 2020 Implementation Committee of Assam University, Silchar.

The Training programme ended with concluding remarks from Resource Persons, Local Coordinator, and Programme Coordinator. This was followed by distribution of certificates to Resource Persons and participants by Principal-in-charge and Programme Coordinator. The formal vote of thanks was extended by Smt.
